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

Cherian George from Hong Kong (Professor & Associate Dean, HKBU School of Communication, Hong Kong) as speakers.





SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT OF TOURISM INDUSTRY DURING PANDEMIC PERIOD




A webinar was organised by PG

Two-Day International Conference on "Contemporary Trends, Challenges & Prospects in Global Business"





INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE ON SOCIAL MEDIA AND DEVELOPING SOCIETIES






CMA ORIENTATION PROGRAMME




SOCIAL OUTREACH PROGRAMME: COMPUTER LITERACY PROGRAMME

STAFF ENRICHMENT PROGRAMME





Thiruvananthapuram chapter on 11.02.2022. The webinar was conducted from 04.00 PM to 05.00 PM IST via ZOOM platform.




CAREER ORIENTATION PROGRAMME - AN INTERACTIVE SESSION FOR THIRD-YEAR BBA STUDENTS

EDUMILE: ONLINE CAREER GUIDANCE PROGRAM FOR MEDIA PROFESSION




EDUMILE: ONLINE CAREER GUIDANCE PROGRAM FOR COMPUTER SCIENCE PROFESSION


Mr.Sandeep P(Alumna 2016-19 batch), Associate System Engineer at Tata Consultancy Services, Kochi.
