
WORKSHOP: "KERALA-A GOOD PLACE FOR BUSINESS"

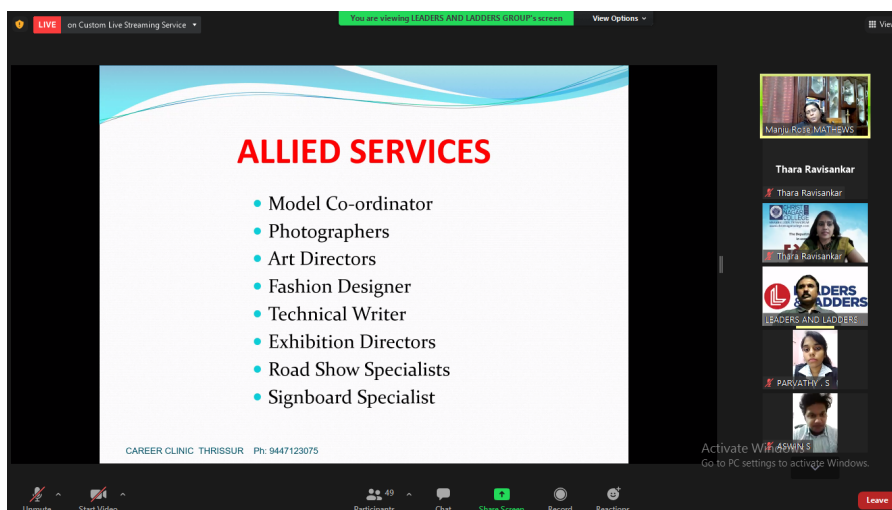
